What people in CA can do to stop the disastrous Republican Senate health bill!

1. **Help keep the pressure on the Republican Senator from Nevada, Dean Heller, until he votes NO on the bill or the Reps drop it.** He says he can't support the bill "in its current form" because of the deep Medicaid cuts-- we must hold him to NO all the way through.

What's at stake? According to the [Congressional Budget Office](#), 15 million uninsured in 2018, rising to 22 million by 2026, plus skyrocketing premiums and out-of-pocket expenses for low-income people and people nearing retirement. The [GOP Senate health bill](#):

- Guts funding for Medicaid by billions of dollars to pay for tax cuts to the rich. These massive Medicaid cuts threaten the most vulnerable in all states: seniors, children and adults with developmental disabilities, paraplegics and other people with severe physical or mental health conditions, nursing home residents, pregnant women.
- Ends Medicaid coverage for working poor adults whose employers don't provide insurance.
- De-funds Planned Parenthood, stripping away a major source of primary care for women.
- Lets states allow private insurance companies to drop maternity care—maternity care!!!—cancer treatment services, opioid addiction and mental health therapy, and many other essential health benefits, while charging much higher co-pays and deductibles, without annual or lifetime caps on what the consumer has to pay out-of-pocket.
