2015 - 2016 Federal Income Guidelines

The Federal Income Guidelines for counting income for your clients have changed effective April 1st, 2015. Click [HERE](#) for updated Health Care Countable Income Comparison Chart. You MUST also update your Core Training binder fact sheets from the materials on our website, otherwise they will be inaccurate. Click [HERE](#) to access those materials. You may want to save a copy of the 2014 - 2015 guidelines to help with retroactive Medi-Cal applications for months prior to April, 2013. That is, if someone applies in April, the countable income limits will be different (lower) for March and February if that person wants coverage for those months.
