Non- MAGI Aged and Disabled Medi-Cal Income Limits Increase

As of April 1st 2016, the income limits for Medi-Cal's Aged and Disabled program have increased to \$1220 a month for a single person and \$1645 for a married couple (if both apply). The asset limits remain the same (\$2000 for a single person and \$3000 for a married couple).
