Cancer Detection Program Every Woman Counts

Changes to Every Woman Counts

Beginning January 1, 2010, the Cancer Detection Program Every Woman Counts (CDPEWC) has changed the age-eligibility for breast cancer screening services to age 50 years and older. Due to budget constraints, CDPEWC has also suspended all new enrollments for breast cancer screening services until July 1, 2010. Women who enrolled previous to January 1, 2010, will continue to receive services; however, they will only be eligible for diagnostic mammograms if they are under age 50.

As of January 1, 2010, CDPEWC will no longer enroll women under age 50 for diagnostic or screening mammograms. Women under 50 who need a mammogram are encouraged to call CDPEWC at 1-800-511-2300 for a referral. Women who are eligible for Family Pact can receive a screening mammogram through that program. Women who are able to obtain a mammogram independently of the CDPEWC program may be eligible for the Breast and Cervical Cancer Treatment Program (BCCTP) and can bring their diagnosis to a CDPEWC provider for a treatment referral to BCCTP.

There will be no changes to eligibility for cervical cancer screening under CDPEWC.
