Medi-Cal Mail-In District Address for Los Angeles County Has Changed. The Department of Social Services (DPSS) has moved the Medi-Cal Mail-In Unit to District # 89.

District # 89 will now be processing Medi-Cal application mailed directly to Los Angeles County DPSS. Any applications received by the former Mail-In Unit, District # 90, will be forwarded to the case-carrying district determined by the applicant's address.
