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Must Close Kaiser Permanente Child Health Plan To New Enrollments

Message from Suber Corley, Director, Charitable Health Coverage Operations:

November 29, 2011

Dear Community Partners and Kaiser Permanente Colleagues

As anticipated, we have quickly reached capacity and must close Kaiser Permanente Child Health Plan to new enrollment in Los Angeles, Orange and San Diego Counties. Effective December 5, 2011, we will not accept applications for new enrollment from residents in these counties.

We will continue to process the enrollment applications we receive via One-E-App (OEA) through close of business on December 5, 2011. However, we must regretfully deny any additional applications we receive after this date.

Our participation in Medi-Cal and Healthy Families will continue, and is not affected by the closure of Kaiser Permanente Child Health Plan.

Please note: Our Southern California region will be closed entirely to new enrollment in KP Child Health Plan. We hope to be able to re-open at some time in the future.

Thank you for the role you have played in helping uninsured children access coverage through Kaiser Permanente Child Health Plan.

Agencies not funded to use One-e-App can access One-e-App through the public access sites. The client can be with you or on the phone, but the application must be completely submitted by Saturday. This site was designed for families, so the ability to track an application for enrollment confirmation will not be available. Families will be screened for Medi-Cal and Healthy Families as well as other non-health programs, and if they are found not eligible, they will then be given the option to enroll into KPCHP. If you are interested in applying only for KPCHP you can "opt out" of other programs for which the system says a family may be potentially eligible. To get to the public sites, click:
