KAISER PERMANENTE - CHILD HEALTH PLAN UPDATE

Good News! Effective **October 1, 2008**, the renewal process for Kaiser Permanente Child Health Plan has been extended to 24 months. Kaiser will no longer require membership for Kaiser Permanente Child Health Plan at 12 months. Kaiser Permanente Child Health Plan members will receive a letter notifying them of this exciting new change.

Effective Tuesday, Oct. 7th, Kaiser will only accept the following versions of application. You will find the revision date on the front of the application, in lower left corner. These are the only applications considered "current and acceptable" for processing.

Rev. Date (1/2008) - January 2008

Rev. Date (8/2008) - August 2008

The mailroom has been instructed to return any KPCHP applications older than October 2007 to the applicant, along with a revised letter and a new KPCHP application.

Please note: Effective January 1, 2009, the January applications above will be accepted; the only KPCHP applications that will be accepted for new membership are those with a revised date of August 2008.

If you need a quantity of KPCHP applications, please forward your request with the instructions below.
