- 4. What's happening with pregnancy coverage in California?
  - a. Enrollment issues
  - b. Soon pregnant women 60-138% change from "pregnancy-related" to FULL SCOPE Medi-Cal (a good thing) BUT immediate mandatory managed care during any trimester, for transitioning women not a good thing!
  - c. Pregnant women 138-213% of poverty, in pregnancy-related. Still in play will feds determine this coverage as "Minimally Essential" or will state continue with plan for Covered CA premium assistance for this group?
  - d. AIM enrollment scandalously low (issue a)
  - e. AIM-CCS-Every Woman Counts-GHPP- at risk in budget –heads up only at this time.
  - f. Remember pregnant women on ANY kind of Medi-Cal get all adult dental services.
