Rapid re-housing \$\$ increased
Counties and state must meet with advocates/clients quarterly on Cal ACES
Black Infant Health funding expanded and interventions broadened
CHIS data collection strengthened for children and youth
CovCA develop options for financial assistance to low-income and submit by 2-1-19
Three-year “All Children Thrive” pilot to address childhood trauma
MHSA fund for physicians in med shortage areas to enroll in psychiatric fellowship
EITC expansion of eligibility to younger and older workers and increase credit
