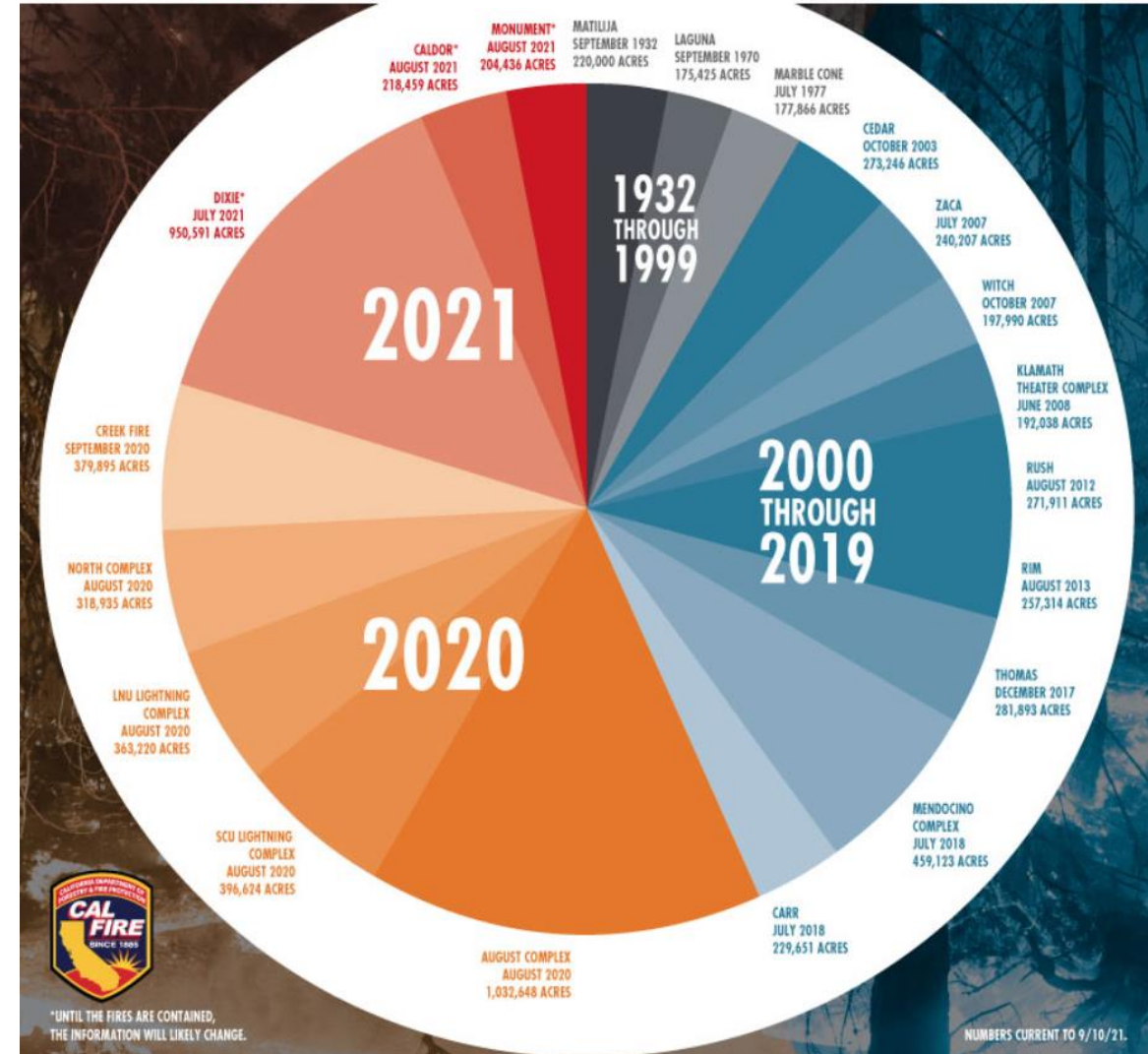

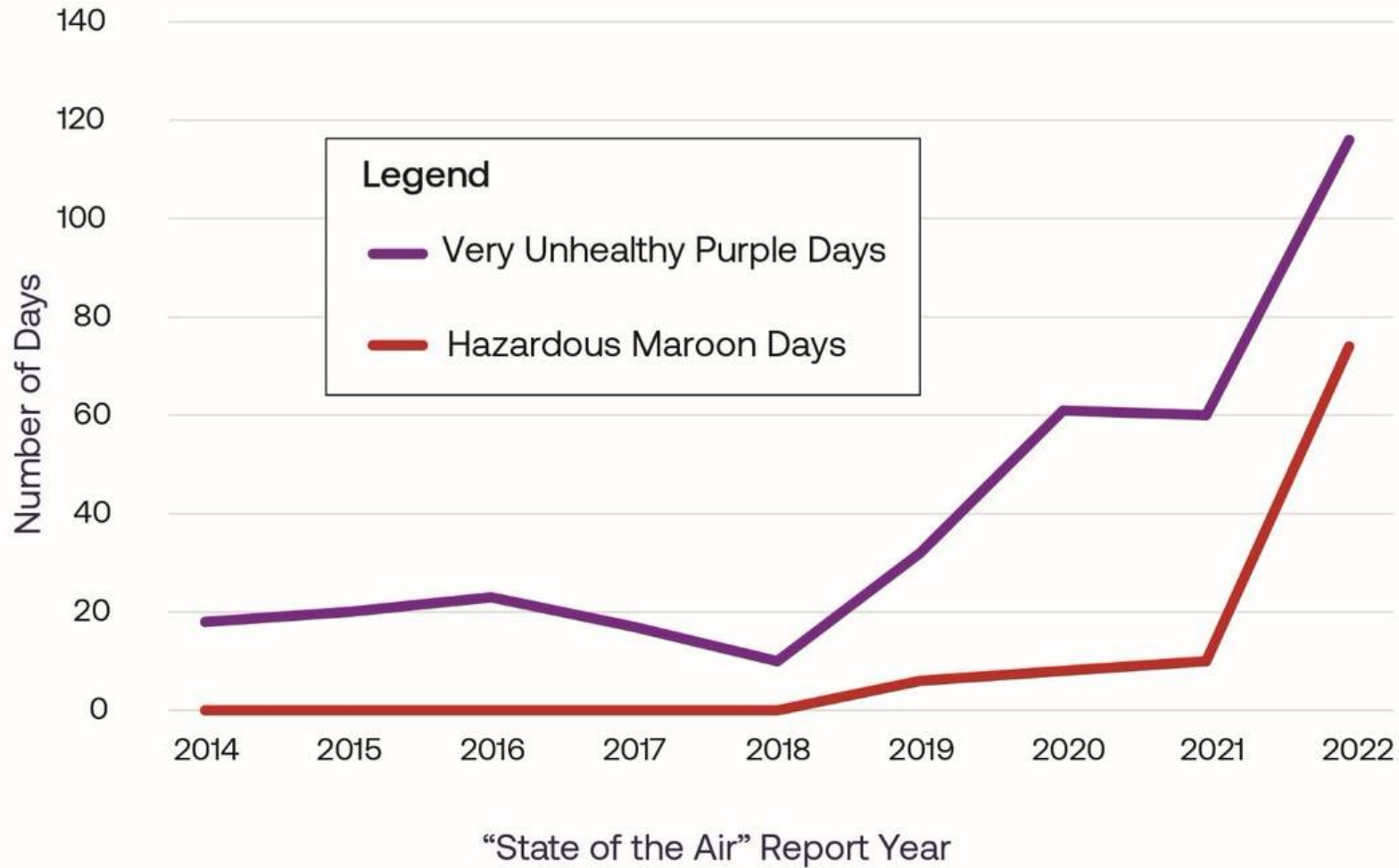
TOP 20 LARGEST CALIFORNIA WILDFIRES
