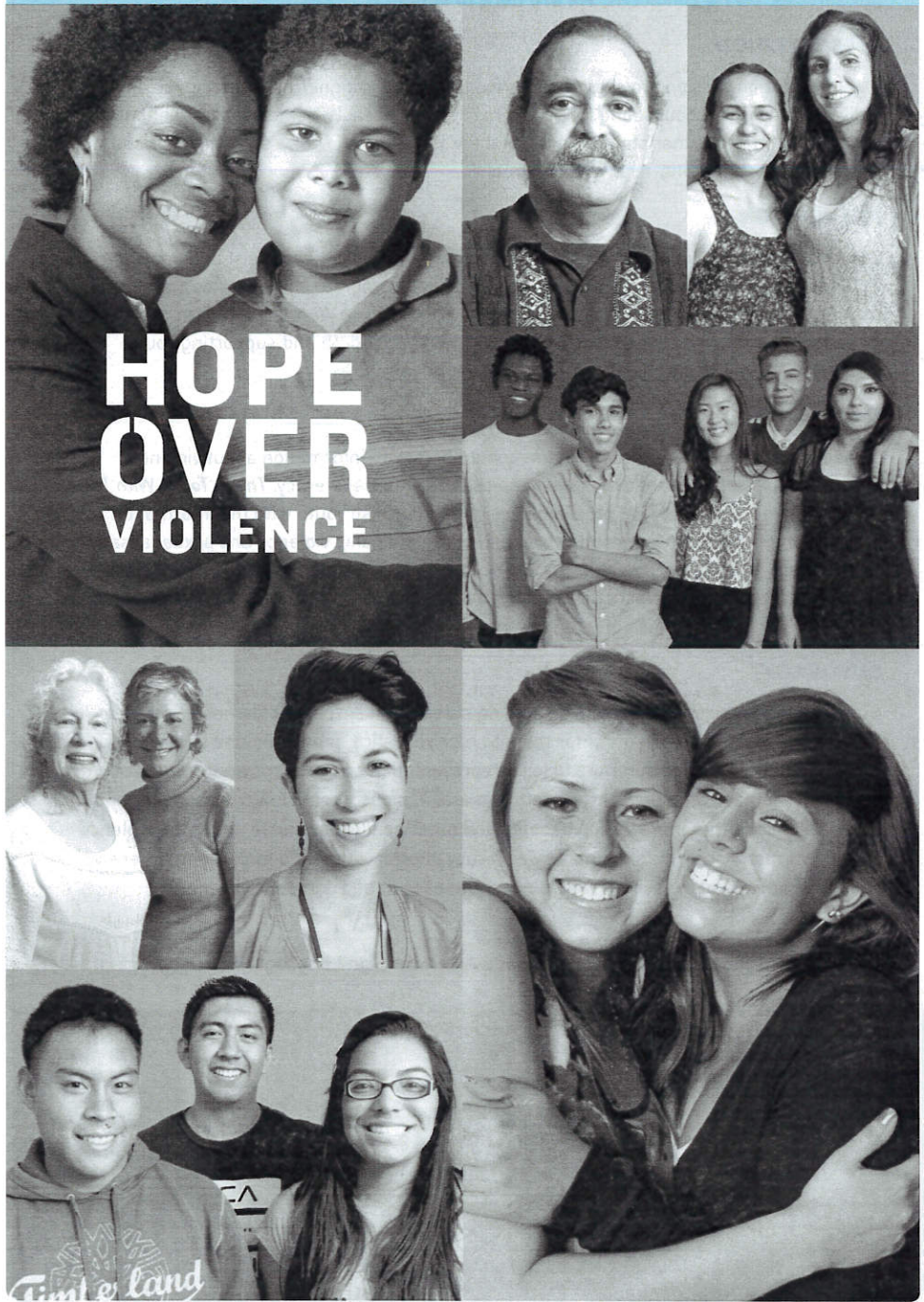

EMERGENCY

Our emergency services offer victims of sexual assault, domestic violence and intimate partner stalking emotional support, information, compassion, accompaniment, referrals and advocacy services, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. If you or someone you know is in need of our services, please contact us. **We are here to serve.**

INTERVENTION

Our intervention division provides services to survivors and significant others, including individual and group counseling for survivors of sexual assault, domestic and relationship violence, intimate partner stalking, and child sexual abuse. We solve short-term crises and facilitate healing for long-term empowerment.

PREVENTION

Our prevention services offer programs that empower individuals to resist and prevent violence in families and communities. Our self defense program concentrates on physical and mental skills for defending against violence. *The In Touch With Teens Program* incorporates many initiatives focusing on violence among youth and supporting youth in making positive decisions about their lives and their futures.

EDUCATION

Our education services provide community members with information about violence prevention, parenting for healthy relationships, and financial literacy. *The In Touch With Teens Curriculum* offers educational programs designed to furnish youth with the information and skills they need in order to recognize and prevent relationship violence and sexual assault. Our staff and trained volunteers, including our survivor speakers bureau, Voices Over Violence, participate in presentations, panel discussions, and media interviews to educate the public about the realities of interpersonal violence.

ADVOCACY

Our advocacy services concentrate on guiding survivors of sexual and domestic violence through the legal system in order for them to receive justice, protection and their due rights. This includes connecting survivors to legal representation and/or empowering survivors to represent themselves in the court system. We assist undocumented survivors in applying for Uvisa relief and other immigration benefits and other benefits available under the Violence Against Women Act. Through our policy advocacy efforts, we seek to make comprehensive change in policy and legislation regarding sexual assault and domestic violence.
