



# VOTE YES ON PROP 63

This November, Californians will have the opportunity to stand up for common sense gun safety reform by voting **YES on PROP 63**. Prop 63 will close dangerous loopholes in our laws and help keep deadly weapons out of dangerous hands by enacting seven lifesaving reforms. Prop 63 will:

**ENSURE PEOPLE CONVICTED OF SERIOUS CRIMES RELINQUISH THEIR FIREARMS AFTER CONVICTION** by requiring them to provide proof to the courts that they sold or transferred their weapons. Though current law requires newly convicted offenders to sell or transfer their guns after conviction, it does nothing to ensure they actually comply. Prop 63 will create a clear, verifiable process for the removal of firearms from dangerous people and will reduce the number—currently in the tens of thousands—of illegally owned firearms in our state.

**TREAT AMMUNITION SALES LIKE GUN SALES** by requiring ammunition purchasers to pass a background check and requiring ammunition sellers to obtain a business license and submit ammunition sale records to law enforcement.

**HELP LAW ENFORCEMENT BREAK UP GUN TRAFFICKING RINGS AND RETURN LOST OR STOLEN FIREARMS TO THEIR RIGHTFUL OWNERS** by requiring individuals to notify law enforcement if their firearm has been lost or stolen.

**ENSURE GUN DEALERS OPERATE RESPONSIBLY** by requiring their employees to pass background checks and by requiring dealers to notify law enforcement if their ammunition is lost or stolen. Gun dealers must already report the loss or theft of firearms.

**PROTECT CALIFORNIANS FROM MASS SHOOTING** by making it illegal to possess the kind of military-style, large-capacity ammunition magazines that enable mass killings.

**STRENGTHEN OUR BACKGROUND CHECK SYSTEMS** by requiring the California Department of Justice to share crucial data about dangerous individuals with the FBI.

**COMBAT FIREARM THEFT** by clarifying that this crime is punishable as a felony, regardless of the firearm's market value, and by making it illegal for individuals convicted of stealing firearms to purchase or possess them.
