



**Healthy Kids Annual Renewal Screening  
for Members at 134% to 400% of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL)  
Frequently Asked Questions**

**Q: What is the Healthy Kids Annual Renewal Screening for members at 134-400% FPL?**

**A:** Because of new coverage options effective January 1, 2014, some Healthy Kids members may become eligible for other coverage. Members at 134-400% FPL will complete the annual renewal screening process over the phone.

**Q: Why isn't the Healthy Kids Annual Renewal Screening for members in higher income groups – e.g., at 250-400% FPL?**

**A:** Healthy Kids income data is only available in the categories captured in the Healthy Kids Application – i.e., 0-133% FPL, 134-150% FPL, 151-300% FPL, and 301-400% FPL.

**Q: How will Healthy Kids members be notified?**

**A:** Healthy Kids members at 134-400% FPL will receive a letter on or about November 12, 2013 notifying them that an L.A. Care representative will call them to complete the annual renewal over the phone.

**Q: What if a Healthy Kids member at 134-400% FPL completed their Annual Renewal earlier this year?**

**A:** If a Healthy Kids member has completed the annual renewal, the L.A. Care representative will let the family know that, due to new coverage options starting January 1, 2014, they must verify the member's continued eligibility for the Healthy Kids program and help identify if other family members may be eligible for the new coverage options.

**Q: How will Healthy Kids members be assisted if they are eligible for other coverage?**

**A:** Healthy Kids members eligible for other coverage (e.g., Medi-Cal or Covered CA) will be assisted by L.A. Care or referred to their nearby CAA agency. Once the family or a CAA notifies L.A. Care that the member is enrolled in other coverage, the member will be disenrolled from the Healthy Kids program.

**Q: Will eligibility for the Healthy Kids program change?**

**A:** No. Eligibility for the Healthy Kids program will remain the same. Families are eligible for the Healthy Kids 0-5 program if they live in L.A. County, have incomes at or below 400% FPL, not covered by an employer sponsored health insurance in the last 3 months and *not eligible for other coverage* (e.g., Medi-Cal or Covered CA).

**Q: Will the annual renewal screening be based on family income that includes or excludes tax credits?**

**A:** The Healthy Kids annual renewal screening process will use the existing Healthy Kids Application family income calculation.

**Q: Can families apply for the Healthy Kids program during the closed enrollment periods for Covered CA?**

**A:** Families that miss the Covered CA open enrollment period may be able to enroll their child in Covered CA under the "qualifying event" criteria – e.g., birth of a child, moving from one county/region to another, change in guardianship, change in employment status, etc. Given the Healthy Kids eligibility requirements, a child may not be eligible for Healthy Kids and Covered CA.
