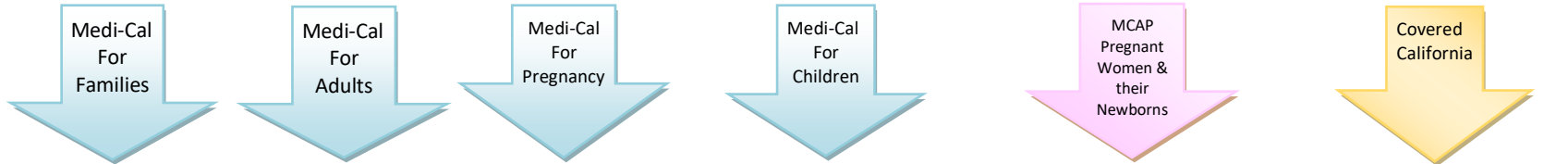

PROGRAM NAME	PROGRAM DESCRIPTION
<b>109%</b> Medi-Cal Program for Parents and Caretaker Relatives	Covers pregnant women with other children in the home or who are in their 3rd trimester. Full scope for women with SIS* and ALL MEDICALLY NECESSARY SERVICES during pregnancy for women that are undocumented; not just a narrow set of prenatal and hospital labor and delivery services.
<b>138%</b> Medi-Cal Program	Pregnant applicants who are citizens or lawfully present immigrants are now eligible for FULL SCOPE Medi-Cal with household income through 138% of poverty. ALL MEDICALLY NECESSARY SERVICES during pregnancy for women that are undocumented; not just a narrow set of prenatal and hospital labor and delivery services.
<b>213%</b> Medi-Cal Program for Pregnant women	Women in Pregnancy-Related Medi-Cal with income 139%- 213% of poverty are entitled to ALL MEDICALLY NECESSARY SERVICES during pregnancy, not just a narrow set of prenatal and hospital labor and delivery services. This applies to all women enrolled in Pregnancy Medi-Cal with income through 213% of poverty, including the undocumented.
<b>266%</b> Medi-Cal Targeted Low Income Children's Program with premium 161% to 266% - Children up to 19	Children 0 to 19 years are eligible if their family income is below 266% of the poverty level. Full scope for all eligible children regardless of immigration status. Children with family income between 161% – 266% of the poverty level will pay a \$13 monthly premium.
<b>214% - 322%</b> Medi-Cal Access Program (MCAP) Formerly known as Access for Infants and Mothers (AIM)	MCAP is a state insurance program for pregnant women without regard to immigration status and their newborns who are over income for Medi-Cal. Many pregnant women who are eligible for MCAP may also qualify for Covered California with subsidies, called Advanced Premium Tax Credits, or Cost-Sharing Reductions, But even with subsidies, Covered California can be expensive for low-income women. <b>214% - 600%</b> Covered California. Applicants with income below 600% may qualify for premium assistance subsidies.	Pregnant women who are eligible for Covered California with subsidies, called Advanced Premium Tax Credits, or Cost-Sharing Reductions, may also qualify for MCAP. Even with subsidies, Covered California can be expensive for low-income women and MCAP may be a cheaper option.
