PROGRAM NAME	PROGRAM DESCRIPTION
<b>109%</b> Medi-Cal Program for Parents and Caretaker Relatives (Family Medi-Cal)	<b>You Must Report the Pregnancy to the County!</b> This Medi-Cal program covers pregnant individuals with other children in the home or who are in their 3rd trimester. Medi-Cal participants are eligible for comprehensive coverage, regardless of their immigration status.
<b>138%</b> Medi-Cal Program (Income Eligible)	<b>You must report the pregnancy to the county!</b> This Medi-Cal program is for individuals whose income qualifies for Medi-Cal, including those pregnant. Medi-Cal participants are eligible for comprehensive coverage, regardless of their immigration status.
<b>213%</b> Medi-Cal Program for Pregnant Individuals (Pregnancy Medi-Cal) AND  Presumptive Eligibility Medi-Cal for Pregnant People ( <b>PE4PP</b> )	<b>Medi-Cal for Pregnancy</b> , for those with income between 139% - 213% of poverty. Medi-Cal participants are eligible for Full Scope coverage, regardless of their immigration status.  <b>Presumptive Eligibility Medi-Cal</b> is designed to provide immediate, temporary coverage for ambulatory (no overnight hospitalization) pregnancy-related care and abortion to low-income, pregnant individuals pending the approval of a formal Medi-Cal application
<b>266%</b> Medi-Cal Program for Children up to age 19	Covers individuals, including those pregnant, up to 19 years old with family income at or below 266% of the poverty level. Medi-Cal participants are eligible for Full Scope coverage, regardless of their immigration status.
<b>214% - 322%</b> Medi-Cal Access Program (MCAP)	MCAP is a state insurance program for pregnant people whose income exceeds the Medi-Cal program for pregnancy. Many pregnant individuals who are eligible for MCAP may also qualify for Covered California with subsidies, called Advanced Premium Tax Credits. But, even with subsidies, Covered California can be expensive. <b>139% - 400% and up</b> Covered California. Applicants may qualify for premium assistance premium tax subsidies.	Pregnant people who are eligible for or already enrolled in Covered California with subsidies, called Advanced Premium Tax Credits, or Cost-Sharing Reductions, may instead qualify for MCAP. Even with subsidies, Covered California can be expensive and MCAP may be a cheaper option with added benefits for their newborn.
