Maintenance Need Level (MNL)	Medi-Cal allows families a portion of their income for living expenses, called the Maintenance Need Level (MNL). Once other eligibility				
Non-MAGI Medi-Cal	requirements are met, family size and income determine if family members can get Medi-Cal at no cost or with a Share-of-Cost (SOC). MNL				
	determines the amount of SOC.				
Medi-Cal, Targeted Low-Income	Medi-Cal for children up to 266% FPL. MCAP-linked infants are eligible for TLICP Medi-Cal at birth and through the second year of age, with
